

*Students are provisionally admitted based on self-reported information from the Cal State Apply application. Our office will verify all admission requirements are met via official transcripts.*



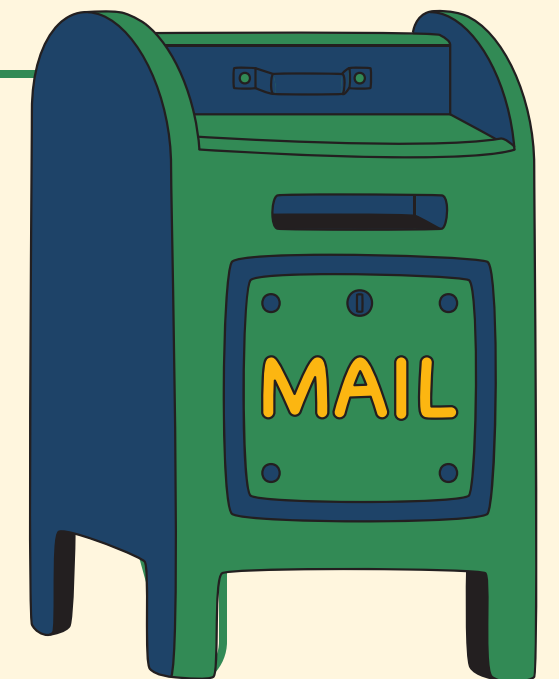
# TRANSCRIPTS

- Must be official
- Be sent by third party transcript/testing service
  - Parchment
  - National Clearinghouse
  - CollegeBoard
- Be directly sent from the school to:  
verify@cpp.edu
- Mailed to Cal Poly Pomona
- Final transcripts due by 7/15 (posted HS graduation date & grades through senior year)

# DUAL ENROLLMENT

---

## DID YOU TAKE CLASSES AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR OTHER UNIVERSITY?

- CPP NEEDS OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS
- COLLEGES WILL NOT SEND TRANSCRIPTS ON YOUR BEHALF
- IF THE CLASS IS A NON-A-G COURSE, IT MAY NOT APPEAR ON HS TRANSCRIPT

## CAN I TAKE SUMMER COURSES?

- Yes, students can take Community College courses during the Summer
- A-G requirements must be met high school graduation



# EXTERNAL EXAMS

## Advanced Placement (AP)


- Official score report from CollegeBoard
- Score of 3 or higher
- Up to 6 units of college credit (per exam)

## International Baccalaureate (IB)

- Score of 4 or higher on HL (Higher Level) exams
- Up to 9 units of college credit (per exam)



- Parts 1: May 1, 2024
- Part 2: May 28, 2024
- Part 3: July 15, 2024
- Asynchronous and self-paced
- Complete Parts 1 & 2 prior to your live orientation
- Completion of your pre-orientation modules is **mandatory**

## Live Orientation Session

- Every Monday, Wednesday & Friday starting June 10
- Time: 7:30AM – 5:30PM
- Session availability is based on your academic record
- Attendance to your live orientation session is **mandatory**

# BRONCO ORIENTATION EXPERIENCE

- **Advising and Registration is built into your Orientation Day**
  - You will meet with an advisor during your scheduled orientation
- **Each of you have unique needs and wants – at CPP, we want to ensure you have a say in your orientation experience**
  - Students will see four learning pathway options at the point of registration
  - We encourage you to read through each pathway description as you decide what your Bronco Orientation Experience will entail
- **Students and their guests will have two separate orientation experiences**
  - Parent and Family Orientation is meant to provide guidance and information to your supporters as they learn to navigate CPP and join the Bronco Family





# ORIENTATION RESERVATION

- **Students can make a reservation via MyCPP- BroncoDirect.**
  - Registration will open on Wednesday, May 1
  - Students must have submitted their Intent to Enroll to make an orientation reservation
  - Students are allowed up to two guests with their reservation
- **The final deadline to make an orientation reservation is Monday, June 3 at 11:59pm**
  - Failure to make an orientation reservation will result in your CPP admission being withdrawn
- **Adjusting Your Reservation**
  - To add a guest, please do not cancel your current reservation
  - Students can contact [orientation@cpp.edu](mailto:orientation@cpp.edu) to make any updates to their current reservation

**Deadline to make an orientation reservation is Monday, June 3**

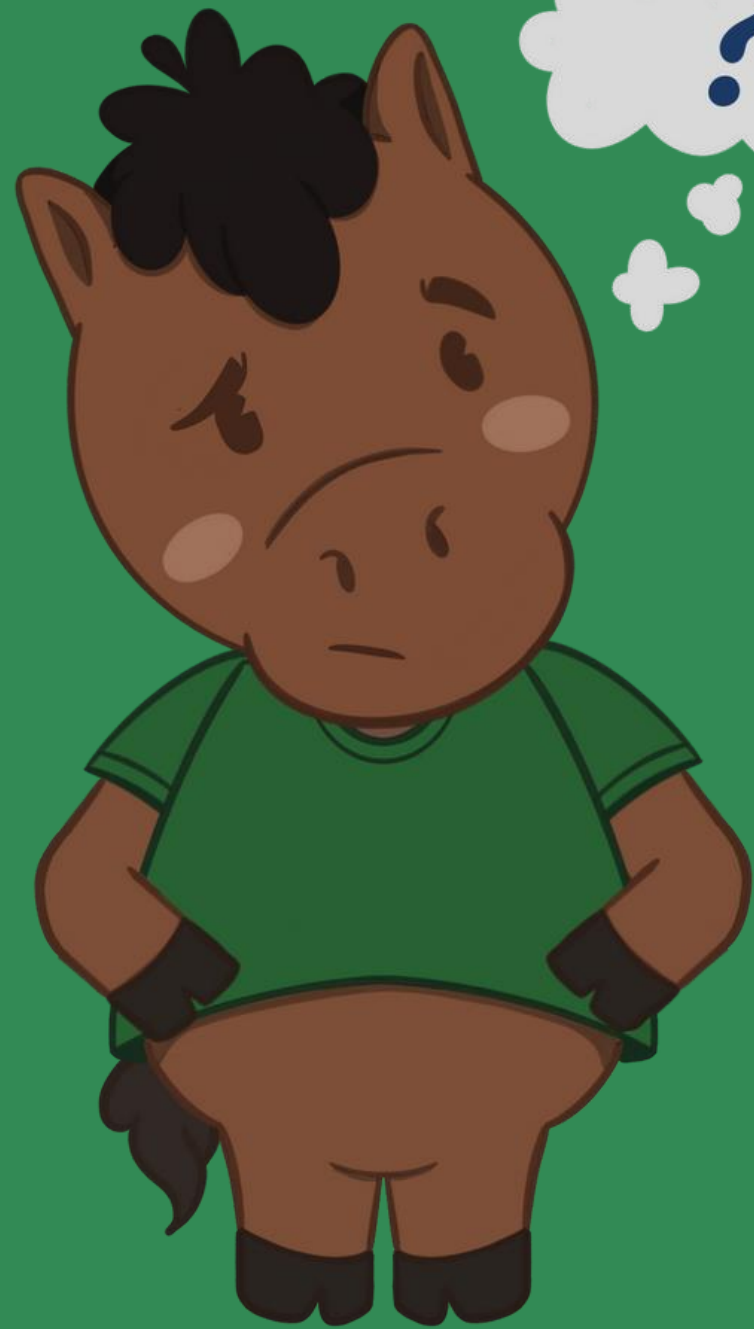

- Visit Student Success for advising directory and info about assigned advisor

## Billy Chat

- Artificial intelligence text-messaging robot
- You can text Billy questions 24/7
- CPP will send you reminders about dates, announcements and campus services
- Check or update your cell phone number so Billy can reach you
- Save Billy's number in your phone!



# WHAT IF I'M NOT SURE ABOUT MY MAJOR?

## Can I change my major later?

- Change of major can only be requested after the first term, for unimpacted majors
- Impacted majors have additional, specific requirements to change majors. These requirements may take multiple years to complete.

## Recommendations:

- Meet with a career counselor and faculty in your first term to discuss how your CPP Choice major can help you to achieve your career goals

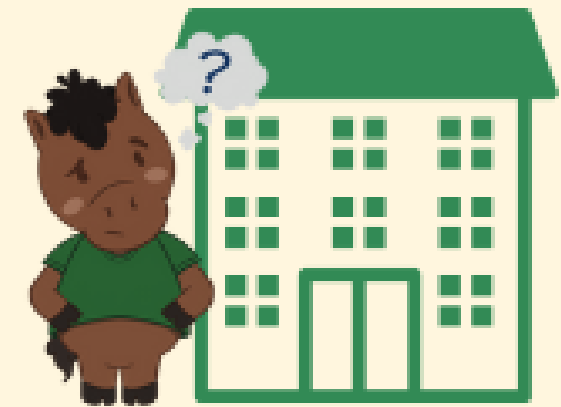
