- Respect and uphold the Association's bylaws, process, values and commitment to Cal Poly Pomona.
- Become a lifetime member of the Alumni Association or in or, pay your membership dues in a timely manner.
- During a non Covid-19 Year- Be present for at least 2 Alumni Association sponsored events per academic year including but not limited to: Annual Pumpkin Patch Alumni Event, Alumni/Student Networking Dinner, Senior Send Off, Gradfair, Distinguished Alumni Awards Gala, Tasting and Auction, Professor for a Day, Chapter Events, etc.
- Serve on at least one committee as needed per year and understand that this will require meeting attendance and active participation.
- Understand that authority rests with the Board as a whole and not with individuals.
- During a non- Covid-19 year, attend Board retreats where training, guidance and planning for the year will take place.
- Attend Board meetings on a regular basis. When unable to attend, will notify the Office of Alumni and External Relations 24 hours in advance. Board members who miss more than 2 of the 4 regularly scheduled meetings- September retreat; November, February and May Board meetings will be subject to removal.
