

CLASS – Com – Cecil B. Brown Memorial Scholarships

Description

All communication majors are eligible for one of two Cecil B. Brown Memorial Scholarships (can be any track in the Communication Department, including public relations, journalism, organizational communication, or interpersonal communication).

This is a one-time award (i.e., recipients will receive the award in one payment during the Fall 2020 semester); previous recipients are not eligible.

The award is a one-time \$2500 scholarship. Two student applicants will be awarded a \$2500 scholarship (total of \$5000 worth of scholarship funds).

To be considered for Fall 2020 disbursement, applicant(s) must meet the following criteria:

- Open to all undergraduate students majoring in Communication; however, applicants must be graduating no earlier than Fall 2020 (graduating seniors cannot apply).
- Cumulative and Cal Poly Pomona GPA must be greater than or equal to 3.25
- Answer and provide all supplemental questions after completing your general application.

Awards each year are based on the student's general application and supplemental responses. The Scholarship Committee of the Department of Communication will decide the recipients.

To begin the application process, please complete your general application first, then proceed to search this scholarship in the "Opportunities >> Ours" tab and click on APPLY. Applications are due by March 17, 2020.

** In addition to the online application form, student applicants are required to completed supplemental questions:

- **Please upload a current resume.**
- **Please upload a personal statement that outlines the applicant's educational and career goals.**

Selection Process: Awards each year are based on the student's general application and supplemental responses. The Scholarship Committee of the Department of Communication will decide the recipients. Note - finalists *may* be interviewed by the Communication Department's Student Scholarships Committee.
