- Create medical, legal, and literary translations and video subtitles.
- Produce creative and media texts, podcasts, and videos.
- Discuss business cases in the Spanish-speaking world.
- Engage in conversations with actors and creators from the Hispanic world.
- Present their creative or research projects in undergraduate conferences.
