DIRECTOR'S NOTE

On February 21, 2012, five young women began a performance inside Moscow's Cathedral of Christ the Saviour. The women were Pussy Riot, the Russian feminist punk band. Film of their being pulled off the church altar was combined with other performance footage of their song "Punk Prayer: Mother of God Drive Putin Away" and uploaded to the internet, immediately becoming a viral sensation.

Three prominent members of Pussy Riot, Maria Alyokhina, Nadya Tolokonnikova and Yekaterina Samutsevich, were soon arrested and held without bail. Their trial, which led to a conviction for "hooliganism motivated by religious hatred", was widely publicized and received international attention. Their sentence of two years in prison was protested around the world.

This play mostly occurs during the trial; in fact, almost the entire text is taken verbatim from court transcripts, interviews and other public comments. It travels freely between the court proceedings, flashbacks and moments of fantasy courtesy of a composite character in the form of a university history professor who has been imprisoned and who will never see the light of day again. Yes, it is reminiscent of dissident leader Alexei Navalny, who "mysteriously" died in a Russian gulag earlier this year. The actors in the play tell us that they are portraying Russian "yorodivy" who in Russian history are the "holy fools", the Orthodox tradition of saints who strive with imaginary insanity to reveal the insanity of the world. Actors portraying yorodivy portraying characters in a nightmare of unbelievable reality.

This play was written in 2015. It could have been written in 2024. Among many things, it's a cautionary tale for those of us here in the United States. We recently were lucky enough to meet Nadya Tolokonnikova at an event in Los Angeles. Minutes before, she told the audience that Vladimir Putin is afraid of democracy and begged us to vote on November 5th. And as playwright Barbara Hammond writes, the play is "about a narrow window of time where activist art, religion, and politics clashed on the world stage."

We hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to be entertained, perhaps to reflect, and to consider what we can individually and collectively do to ensure we don't do this to our own citizens.
