PROJECT SCOPE

The Collins College Expansion addresses the college's growth needs in a sustainable way by striving to achieve LEED Gold certification. In addition to more classrooms and faculty offices, this expansion creates a home base for the new master's program and provides a student commons for studying and co-curricular activities. The classrooms will utilize cutting edge technology and innovative "flex" furniture designed to move and adapt to the evolving needs of today's classroom. The buildings will include:

- three flex classrooms
- two 48-seat lecture rooms
- 32-station lecture room
- spacious student commons with study and social space and a grab n go restaurant
- executive director offices for graduate education and professional development
- executive administrative and lobby space
- 6 faculty offices
- conference room
- 2 group study rooms
