



## CPPARC

500 HOUR CERTIFIED INTERNSHIP SATISFIED

1. COM 2204 (A1), ENG 2105 (A3), MAT 1060 (B4), and PHY 1210/L (B1/B3) should be completed by end of fall of 2nd year. **However, the most important** courses to complete are MAT 1060 and PHY 1210/L by fall of 2nd year- this is required. Remember, MAT 1060 is a prerequisite to PHY 1210/L and the A2 is a prerequisite to ENG 2105. COM 2204 and ENG 2105 can be taken at any time; however, they are typically required to be complete before you take your upper division GE's- B5, C3, D4. You can also take these classes over summer that are 1000 or 2000 (lower division) at a local community college using [Assist.org](http://assist.org/). Verify with ARC staff advisor before doing so.

2. Additional GE's that overlap with the ARC curriculum are: ARC 1020/1022A- C2; ARC 3610/3612- C1; ARC 4630-C3

3. For other GE's you can take any course within that area. Review your DPR and speak to your ARC staff advisor for any questions, especially transfer students.

4. Study Abroad Opportunities are available in 4th year.

5. Be sure to take your studio and activity with the same Instructor. (i.e. ARC 1021A and 1021 has to be with same instructor).
