Move-In Details

- Sunday, August 18 - Wednesday, August 21, *by appointment*
- 30-minute check-in time slots
- Sign up and changes through Housing Portal
- 'Early Move-in Request' open now
 - Daily fee
 - Approval based on room availability



What to Expect Move In Day

- Check-In at your assigned Housing Community:
 - Traditional Halls (Encinitas, Montecito, Alamitos, Aliso)
 - Parking and carts in F Lot
 - Check-in at your assigned building lobby
 - Residential Halls (Sicomoro, Secoya)
 - Parking in Lot Q
 - Check-in and carts at Sicomoro MultiPurpose Room (73 MPR)
 - Suites (Estrellas, Montanas, Bonita, Sol, Luna)
 - Parking in Lot Q
 - Check in and carts at Suites MultiPurpose Room (52 MPR)



What to Expect Move In Day

- UHS and CPP staff and students are available to welcome and assist!
- Moving carts/dollies available for short-term usage (you may want to bring your own)
- Elevators in Residential Halls (8-floors) and Suites (3-4 Floors). No Elevators in Traditional Halls (3-story)
- Parent and Family lounges
- Dining Hall and Bookstore Open
- Warm weather – stay hydrated



Packing List, Things to Bring...

Things NOT to Bring...

 - Rice cookers, air fryers, coffee pots, toasters, toaster ovens, instant pots
- Pets or unapproved emotional support animals
- Sting/decorative lights
- Weapons/toys that resemble weapons
- Alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia

Dining and Meal Plans

- Meal plans are activated on Friday, 8/16
- Your student's Bronco ID will be automatically activated
- Ways to use meal plan:
 - Tap Technology
 - Virtual ID on phone (QR Code)
 - Traditional Swipe
- Optionally enroll in Morpho Wave technology for entry into Centerpointe
- Broncoonecard.com

Choosing A Meal Plan (Lifestyle)

140 Plan (*140 meal swipes + \$660 Dining Dollars* per semester*) Designed for the student who may choose to dine at Centerpointe 1-2 times per day and is frequently not on campus during weekends.

180 Plan (*180 meal swipes + \$560 Dining Dollars* per semester*) Designed for the student who may choose to dine at Centerpointe 2-3 times per day and is mostly on campus during weekends.

220 Plan (*220 meal swipes + \$460 Dining Dollars* per semester*) Designed for the student who may choose to dine at Centerpointe 3 times per day and is mostly on campus during weekends.

Unlimited Plan (*No dining dollars*) Designed for students who prefer to come and go as they wish at Centerpointe Dining Commands. Ideal for athletes and those who prefer smaller, frequent, healthy meals and snacking opportunities.

Unlimited Plus (*Unlimited meals plus \$250 Dining Dollars*) Designed for students who prefer to come and go as they wish at Centerpointe Dining Commands. Ideal for athletes and those who prefer smaller, frequent, healthy meals and snacking opportunities.

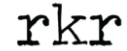
