## Class Pass Fast Facts

### What's a Class Pass?

The Class Pass gives current students at Cal Poly Pomona **unlimited rides on Foothill Transit local and Silver Streak** all year long. It also helps the community by reducing traffic and parking congestion around campus.

### Who is eligible for the Class Pass?

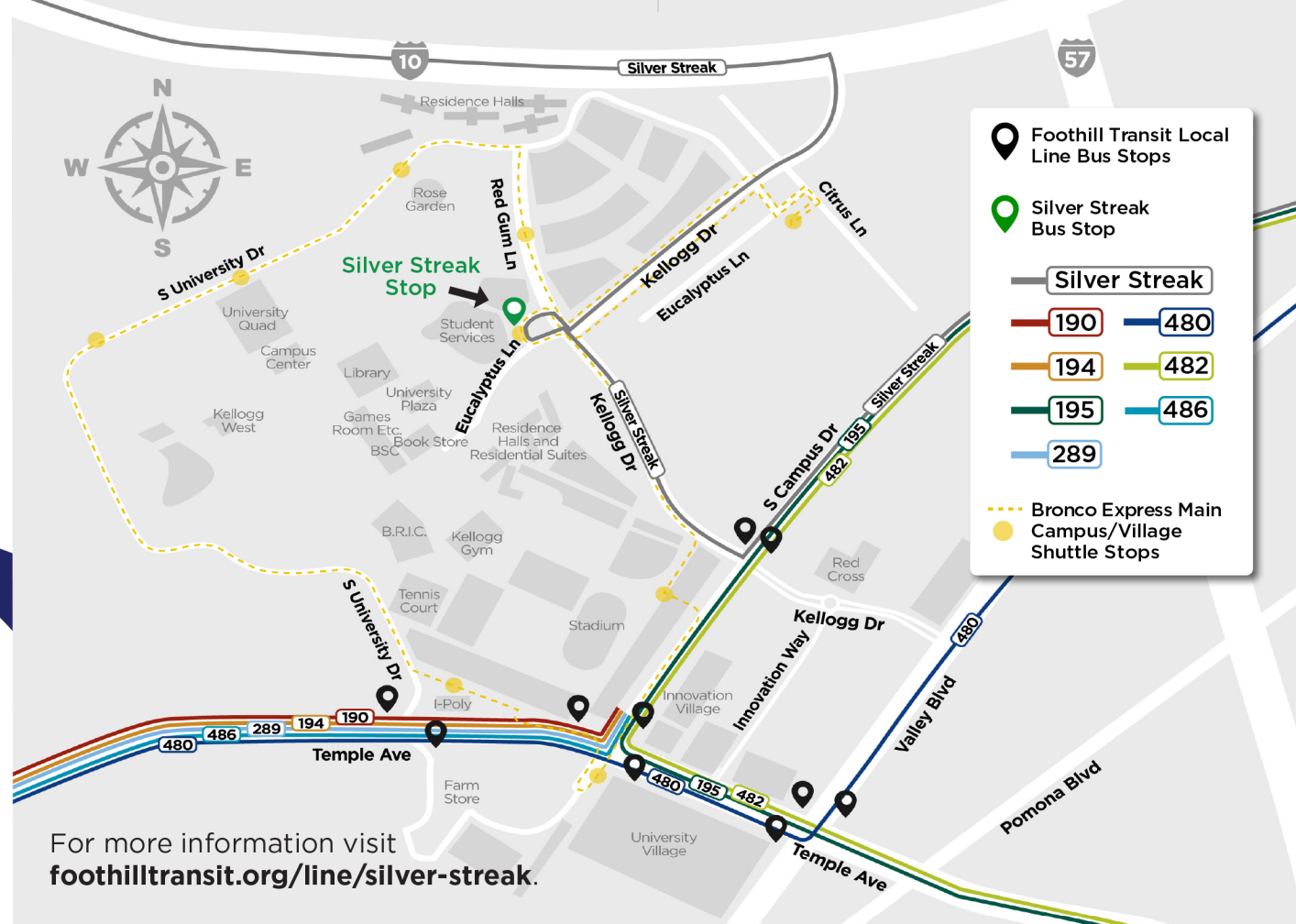
All currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate students with at least 1 credit unit at Cal Poly Pomona are eligible to get a Class Pass. Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Online Learning and Certificate enrolled students are not eligible.

### Where can I use it?

The Class Pass is accepted on all Foothill Transit Local and Silver Streak buses, which connect to 22 different cities throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona valleys, plus downtown Los Angeles.

### Which lines serve Cal Poly Pomona?

Foothill Transit **Lines 190, 194, 195, 289, 480, 482, and 486** have stops along Campus Dr. and Temple Ave. The **Silver Streak** travels between Montclair and downtown Los Angeles, which stops at the Student Services Building between the hours of 7AM to 7PM.

### How do I get a Class Pass?

### How does the Class Pass work?

When you board the bus, simply touch your Class Pass on the TAP symbol right on the farebox until you hear a beep - that means your fare was accepted, and you, my friend, are riding for free!

### When can I use my Class Pass?

The Class Pass has you covered for the whole school year as long as you're enrolled in classes!

### What if I lose my Class Pass?

Just visit the Bronco Student Center, Games Room, Etc. (Bldg. 35-1110) to report your lost pass

and pay a \$10 replacement fee. You'll get a new Class Pass on the spot!

### Where can I go with my Class Pass?

Anywhere Foothill Transit goes, you can go, too! Buses travel throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona valleys, and downtown Los Angeles. Catch a **Silver Streak** bus right outside of the Student Services Building or at the El Monte Station or Pomona Transit Center for an easy ride to see events at the **Crypto Arena** or a night out at **LA Live**.
