

CLASSES ARE HELD AT CAL POLY POMONA AND AT FASHION BUSINESS INC. IN DOWNTOWN LOS ANGELES





The cost per unit is \$280. A four unit class will be \$1,120 and 16 units will be \$4,480. Certificates will take three to four quarters to complete or can be taken at the students own pace. Students may also take courses individually (some require prequalification). Fall quarter classes run between September 26th and December 6th followed by exam week. Courses will run weekday evenings on a quarterly calendar for 10 weeks of study.

Meetings for classroom only courses will be held at **Fashion Business Inc.** in the California Market Center, Los Angeles. In Fall 2013, these include:

AMM 101 (4 units), Intro to the Fashion Industry AMM 357 (3 units) Apparel Importing & Exporting.

Classes with a laboratory-based element will be delivered on the **Cal Poly Pomona** campus:

AMM 112L (1 unit) Digital Illustration for Fashion

AMM 180L (1 unit) Apparel Construction

AMM 301/301L (3 units) Apparel Product Analysis.

Lectures will be in hybrid format (part online, part face-to-face) with one meeting per week. Credit towards a certificate may be given for up to 8 baccalaureate quarter units from recognized transfer institutions. Up to 36 quarter units may be used towards a CSU degree.
